Confirmation 1 Saint Report

Each candidate **must** choose a Confirmation name, whether the Baptismal name is kept or a new name is chosen. In choosing a Confirmation name, the candidate must choose a canonized saint. By doing so, each candidate has a model for holiness and a patron and intercessor. Each Confirmation candidate is **required** to write a Saint Report about the saint whose name he/she has chosen to be their Confirmation name.

This report is intended to **deepen your knowledge of and devotion** to your chosen saint.

Deadline: Sunday, April 12th, 2026

Saint Report Guidelines and Requirements:

- Type a 1-2 page and double-spaced report on your Confirmation saint.
- **Note:** A person that hand writes their report will need to redo it again.

The report must include the following:

In the top left corner of the page:

- First and Last Name
- "Confirmation Year 1"
- "Saint Report 2025-2026"

Paragraph 1: Saint's Biographical Information

- Date and place of birth
- Important events in the saint's life and death
- Description of saint's service to God and others
- Saint's Feast Day and Patron Saint of _____
- Symbol of the saint (if available)

Paragraph 2: What virtues did this saint practice? Use specific examples from their life.

Paragraph 3: Why should Christians today turn to this saint? What should we strive to imitate from their life?

Paragraph 4: Why is this saint important to you? Why did you select this saint?

- Please provide an in-depth explanation.
- What's the connection you have with this saint?

Paragraph 5: How do you plan to look after their example? What are some things that you can put into practice that your Saint did or said?

- Be specific.

Reminders:

- Capitalize references to God (Ex: God, Lord, He, Him and Trinity) and to holy people, places, or things (Ex: Pope, Mass, Bible and Catholic Church)
- Remember, these must be canonized saints.

Note: Saints that are non-canonized and unrecognized by the Catholic Church, will not be accepted and will result in you needing to retype your report.
